 - Your obedience to the words of Jesus is how you <u>remain</u> in Jesus. 15:4-5,9-10;14:15-24

Warning: Failure to obey the words of Jesus leads to a worthless life. 15:6

- Your obedience to the words of Jesus will <u>produce joy</u> in your life. 15:11
- Your obedience to the words of Jesus will demonstrate your <u>friendship</u> with Jesus. *15:8,13-15*
- Your obedience to the words of Jesus will <u>prioritize</u> your prayer life. 15:7,16
- Your obedience to the words of Jesus will lead you to love one another. 15:9-10, 12,17

Reminder: The Helper, comforter and counselor was promised and now He is <u>present</u> in all who have believed in Jesus. *14:26; 15:26-27; 16:13-14*
