The book of Hebrews challenges us to be anchored in the truth that Christ is our superior Savior and faithful high priest for our great salvation.

You can know Christ is superior as the Son of God because He ...

- declares the plans of the Father. 1:1-2a
- is the deserving heir of all things. 1:2b
- is God in human flesh. 1:3a
- is the eternal creator and sustainer of the universe. 1:2c,3b,10-12
- is the savior seated at the right hand of the Father. 1:3c
- is identified by the Father as His son. 1:4-5
- is worshipped by the angels who serve Him. 1:6-7,13-14
- is the promised victorious eternal king of an eternal kingdom. 1:8-9,13

The writer of Hebrews warns us about five dangers we may face as followers of Christ.

1. Failure to pay attention to the truth of who Christ is leads to the danger of drifting from your faith. 2:1-4
2. Failure to fix your thoughts on Jesus leads to the danger of a spiritually hard heart that misses God's best. 3:7-4:13
3. Failure to pursue maturity in Christ leads to the danger of living a spiritually worthless life. 5:11-6:20
4. Failure to persevere in your faith because of deliberate sin leads to the danger of losing eternal reward. 10:26-39
5. Failure to obey the word of the Lord leads to the danger of experiencing divine discipline. 12:25-29
