Finish Well! Hebrews 3:7-4:11

The book of Hebrews challenges us to be anchored in the truth that Christ is our superior Savior and faithful high priest for our great salvation.

Warning: Failure to fix your thoughts on Jesus leads to the danger of a spiritually hard heart that misses God's best. 3:7-4:13

The wandering Israelites teach us that hard hearted rebellion against God produces <u>catastrophic</u> <u>results.</u> 3:7-11; 15-19; I Corinthians 10:1-10

You avoid the fate of the Israelites when you hold firmly to the end your confidence in Christ. 3:12-14

- Don't <u>turn away</u> from the Lord. Vs. 12
- Help one another stay faithful to the Lord. Vs. 13
- Remember your obedience makes you a partner with Christ. Vs. 14

The good news for the faithful is that because of your <u>commitment</u> to finishing well you will receive a spiritual inheritance in the eternal kingdom. 4:1-11

- Be careful to finish well. 4:1
- Disobedient Israel missed what God promised. 4:2
- Obedient believers will receive what God has promised. 4:3-10
- Be diligent to finish well. 4:11
