The book of Hebrews challenges us to be anchored in the truth that Christ is our superior Savior and faithful high priest for our great salvation.

**Main Idea:** The gracious cross work of Jesus has prepared the way for you to be eternally saved and faithfully ministered to by Him as you seek to live a holy life as a member of the family of God.

"You crowned him with glory and honor and put everything under his feet." Heb. 2:7-8

• He is our <u>exalted coming king</u>.

"so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone." Heb. 2:9b

• He is our gracious savior.

"So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers." Heb. 2:11b

• He is our <u>spiritual brother</u>.

"so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death." Heb. 2:14b

• He is our <u>deliverer</u>.

"In order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God" Heb. 2:17b

• He is our faithful High Priest.

"Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted." Heb. 2:18

• He is our <u>helper</u>.

## The writer of Hebrews warns us about five dangers we may face as followers of Christ.

- 1. Failure to pay attention to the truth of who Christ is leads to the danger of drifting from your faith. 2:1-4
- 2. Failure to fix your thoughts on Jesus leads to the danger of a spiritually hard heart that misses God's best. 3:7-4:13
- 3. Failure to pursue maturity in Christ leads to the danger of living a spiritually worthless life. 5:11-6:20
- 4. Failure to persevere in your faith because of deliberate sin leads to the danger of losing eternal reward. 10:26-39
- 5. Failure to obey the word of the Lord leads to the danger of experiencing divine discipline. 12:25-29
